SAFARI!!!

The main stages of your safari at Tembo by Jackson

The first day:

You will usually arrive at Nairobi international airport. To avoid an unnecessary night in a hotel, we recommend that you take a night flight if possible.

You will be met at the airport by our driver, who will take you in a private vehicle either to the hotel we have reserved for you for an overnight stay in a B&B, or to the domestic airport if you plan to reach the Masai Mara by domestic flight (45 minutes), or directly to our bush camp in the Masai Mara, after a journey of 5 to 7 hours, the duration depending on traffic jams to get out of Nairobi and the state of the tracks once you have passed Narok.

If you reach the Masai Mara by plane, your driver-guide will meet you at Musiara Airstrip mid-morning, and you'll already be on your first safari to our bush camp, Tembo by Jackson Bush Camp.

You'll enjoy a warm traditional Maasai welcome as you arrive at the camp, and, after a safety briefing, you'll settle into your tent, or more appropriately your canvas house.

We'll then share a delicious lunch served in the restaurant.

In the early afternoon, we'll set off on a game-drive until nightfall.

Back at camp at around 7pm, a hot shower will be waiting for you, right in your tent, then you can relax in the lounge, where you can discuss your first impressions, or enjoy a delicious cocktail, alcoholic or otherwise.

A delicious dinner prepared by our chefs Joshua, Joseph and Benson will be served, after which you can continue to enjoy the lounge and its bar, or return to your tent, escorted by your askari, for a restorative night's sleep.

Here is a typical day:

Wake up at 5:30 a.m., coffee, tea or chocolate served with dry cakes before an early start (6 a.m.), allowing you to enjoy the magnificent sunrises over the savannah.

Game drive until around 9.30 a.m., then your guide will stop you in the savannah, or on the riverbank, for the always copious and varied breakfast. It's a privileged moment, always much appreciated by safaris.

You'll then continue your safari until around midday, when you'll return to camp for lunch and a rest during the hottest hours.

You'll usually set off again around 4.00 pm for the second safari of the day, lasting until nightfall.

Numerous variations on this typical program are possible, depending on your wishes and the opportunities that the guides have been made aware of:

www.tembobyjackson.com On certain days, you can leave for the whole day and take your lunch with you, especially if a particularly interesting piece of information has been reported: the presence of a cheetah family, the gathering of large herds and the likelihood of crossings, etc. You can also, if you wish, take your lunch with you.

If you wish, and provided everyone in your vehicle agrees, you can also visit Masai villages, schools and local markets with your guide. These are very rich moments of exchange with the Masai community, which also offer great photographic opportunities

The last day:

In all cases, you'll do a final short morning game drive, then return to camp mid-morning if you've chosen to reach Nairobi by road, to enjoy a final brunch before hitting the road again around 11pm, or late morning, after a full safari, if you're flying back in the afternoon.

Our driver will take you in a private vehicle to the international airport for your return flight, or to your hotel if you are continuing your stay in Kenya.

WHAT MAKES TEMBO BY JACKSON SO UNIQUE

Tembo by Jackson is a small, exclusively Kenyan structure, 100% owned by Jackson Naurori, whose reputation as an exceptional guide is well established. The team (about 20 people) is exclusively Maasai, and will welcome you with warmth and professionalism.

The camp, luxurious and intimate (max capacity: 20 to 25 travellers) offers accommodation and food of the highest standard, comparable to the best lodges. It has 6 double tents and 3 family tents, one of which is perfectly adapted to accommodate people with reduced mobility.

Tembo by Jackson Bush camp is ideally located in the heart of the reserve, near the "double cross" area, so you don't have to waste time queuing to enter the reserve in the morning and evening.

The safari schedules are designed for the most demanding photographers and nature lovers: departure in the morning at 6am sharp, return generally around 12pm, afternoon safari from 4pm to 7pm, these schedules being adapted according to the information collected by the guides and the wishes of the clients. The availability of the guides and the flexibility of the organisation are strong points of Tembo by Jackson. For example, there are no restrictions on full-day safaris.

Each Tembo by Jackson vehicle is optimized for shooting and observation, with very large, fully-open windows, a pop-up roof, a large rack for safely transporting photo or video equipment, and each vehicle is also equipped with an exclusive low-slung door for shooting as close to the ground as possible.

In addition to its excellent safari services, Tembo by Jackson is also very involved in the development of local populations.

Tembo by Jackson has created the Masai Mara Solidarity association which actively supports schools in its area, financing the schooling of Maasai children from disadvantaged families, helps villages to store drinking water, participates in programmes facilitating access to work for women, and awareness programmes for the protection of wildlife.

To travel with Tembo by Jackson is to travel ethically, it is also to commit oneself, and to participate actively and concretely in actions of solidarity with the local populations

Your stay at Tembo by Jackson Bush camp

A comfortable camp connected to nature

You will discover the Masai Mara and its legendary wildlife in exceptional comfort, and you will experience your stay in the very heart of the reserve, in the only bush camp that belongs exclusively to a Maasai, which is the pride of its entire community.

Tembo Bush Camp is located in the heart of the Masai Mara Game Reserve, and consists of 9 large, comfortable bush tents for 2 to 6 people (the large family tent), each with its own deck. One tent is fully equipped to host person with reduced mobilityEach tent is equipped with a minimum of one double bed (165cm) or two twin beds with duvet and hot water bottles, a large shower with unlimited hot water, a washbasin, and a European-style flush toilet.

Each tent has LED interior and exterior lighting, and 24-hour electricity, so you can charge your devices (cameras, camera batteries, computers) directly in your tent. There are plenty of European and international plugs available in each tent.

Sheets and towels are provided, as well as organic shower gel and shampoo, bathrobes, flip-flops and rechargeable lamps.

Two very large restaurant and lounge tents and a bar complete the facility, and in these tents you will benefit from a high quality Wifi network, allowing you to stay in touch with your loved ones.

The vehicles that will take you on the game drive are exclusively 4x4 Toyota Land Cruisers, which have been specially adapted for observation and photography (wide, low-slung side openings and large opening roofs, low level door). Two special vehicles can accommodate if requested a family or a group of 7 people

Tents and vehicles are strictly non-smoking.

Energy

The energy needed to light the camp and the tents is provided by a very efficient centralised solar panel installation, which, in normal sunlight, provides electricity 24 hours a day throughout the camp.

In case of insufficient sunlight, the camp is also equipped with two silent generators which ensure the continuity of the electricity supply 24/24. There is no risk of any medical equipment being cut off.

It is recommended that everyone has their own torch (flashlight or headlamp), which you should carry with you at all times after dark.

Security

The camp is located in the middle of the bush, so everyone's behaviour must obey certain basic rules.

As the camp is not fenced, wild animals can move around, sometimes during the day but more frequently at night.

Under no circumstances should you leave the camp if you are not accompanied by a staff member, during the day and even less so at night. In the evening, as soon as the lights go out, you must not leave your tent. One of our night guards (Askari) will allow you to leave at dawn (around 5.30am) after checking that nothing is wrong.

Please make sure that you close your tent as soon as you leave it, so that no animals can get in.

Respecting the environment

Do not throw anything in the savannah, and bring back all your waste (packaging, tissues or paper towels), including cigarette butts (bring your pocket ashtray for smokers). We remind you that the vehicles are strictly non-smoking, so it is only possible to smoke, with caution, during the breakfast break, outside the vehicle.

Water

Water is a rare and precious commodity, so water consumption must be reasonable and economical (especially during showers). The use of plastic bottles is forbidden in the camp, each traveller will be offered an aluminium bottle on arrival.

Alcoholic beverages

It is strictly forbidden to bring alcoholic drinks into the camp. However, you can buy wine or spirits at the bar in the living area, to be consumed on the spot or during your meals, but, for safety reasons, not in the tents.

Safaris (game drive)

Access to the reserve is strictly regulated: from 6:00 am to 7:00 pm

You will be able to leave the camp at 6.00 am precisely, after having swallowed a cup of coffee or tea, accompanied by dry biscuits, while waiting for the much more copious breakfast that you will have in the bush, at the time that you will agree with your quide.

The location of the camp, ideally placed, will allow you to make the most of the park's opening hours, without unnecessary approach routes, and to fix on your sensors or in your minds the extraordinary ambiences of the sunrises and sunsets at the equator.

As a general rule, you will be back at the camp for lunch at the latest at 1pm and will leave at around 4pm, returning to the camp at 7pm at the latest, imperatively.

You can also, whenever necessary (for example a particularly interesting spot far from the camp) go on a "full day game drive" (safari without returning to the camp at noon).

Masai Mara Solidarity

Do not hesitate to ask us, or to speak with the staff once you are there, about the Masai Mara Solidarity Kenya association, and its mirror Masai Mara Solidarité France. You will discover the wonderful field actions supported by Tembo by Jackson to help disadvantaged Masai families, and to help children to access school. The future of the Masai Mara, and its wildlife, depends on the education and the future of the Masai children. And don't hesitate to complete your luggage with clothes, school equipment, "old" phones or tablets, nothing will be wasted. We can travel far, and travel ethically!

Cancellation policy:

Cancellation for any reason:

Cancellation more than 30 days prior to safari start date: 30% of the total safari price will be retained, Cancellation less than 30 days prior to safari start date: 70% of the total safari price will be retained. Cancellation less than 10 days prior to safari departure date: 100% of the total cost of the safari will be retained.

Postponement due to force majeure:

Postponement of more than 30 days from the scheduled departure date: no deduction, the deposit will remain in our books until the trip is completed.

Postponement less than 30 days before scheduled departure: 10% of the total safari price will be retained. The refundable amount (20%) will take the place of the security deposit for the postponed trip, and the 10% withheld will be added to the remaining balance if it has not yet been paid, or invoiced separately if the balance has already been paid.

Free cancellation option (new):

As Tembo by Jackson does not accept payment for stays by credit card, due to the high charges levied by financial institutions, we are offering you a no-cost cancellation option, to be taken out at the same time as your trip, and valid up to 24 hours before the start of the trip, without the need to provide us with proof. This no-cost cancellation will be billed at 5% of the total amount and is non-refundable.

Cancellation more than 30 days before the safari start date: 30% of the total amount of the safari will be retained, Cancellation less than 30 days before the start of the safari: 70% of the total amount of the safari will be retained


